

MAE135 Guidelines for Homework Assignments

Compliance with the following guidelines will greatly facilitate fair and timely grading of the homeworks. Homework counts considerably (30% of the total grade) for the following reason: it is the best way to learn the material. If you complete and understand all of the homeworks, you will likely do very well in the exams.

1. You are expected to complete all homeworks by their due date. All homeworks will count towards your grade (no homework will be dropped).
2. Your write-up should be neat, concise, and single-sided. Messy and/or unreadable homeworks will receive a poor grade, even if they seem correct. Avoid unnecessarily long answers.
3. Make sure you understand what the problem asks for. If in doubt, ask the instructor. Irrelevant statements receive no credit.
4. The homework you submit must represent your own work. You must try solving the problems by yourself. If difficulties remain, consult the instructor. Don't copy from someone else's work and don't let anybody copy from your work. The penalty for plagiarism will be zeroing of the suspect homework and possible expulsion from class.
